William Ernest Hunter, Jr., 83, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, March 27, 2015 at Vidant Edgecombe Hospital in Tarboro.

He was born on February 29, 1932 in Kannapolis, to the late William and Maude Rhyne Hunter. Mr. Hunter was a US Army veteran, where he was a Top Secret Message Carrier from Karlsruhe to Manheim Hildesheim, Germany from October 1953 to November 1954. He also delivered mail to Heidelberg. After deployment he worked in the parts department at Carolina Freight Carriers for 37 years in Cherryville, NC. Mr. Hunter was a member of the VFW and Williamson's Chapel United Methodist Church in Mooresville.
