



## William John Hladik, Sr.

December 23, 1933 - July 11, 2022

William John Hladik, Sr., 88, of Mooresville, passed away on Monday, July 11, 2022.

He was born on December 23, 1933 in Schenectady, NY, to the late Anthony and Johanna Sefcovic Hladik. Mr. Hladik was a veteran serving in the US Army, and he worked at IBM for 26 years. He volunteered with Habitat for Humanity for 21 years and was the first recipient of the Golden Hammer award. Mr. Hladik loved to build things, including his own lake home. He collaborated with his son Bill to create software that allowed habitat volunteers to quickly make all the lumber cuts needed to build a complete home. Mr. Hladik was a member of St. Therese Catholic Church in Mooresville.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a daughter, Susan Thrailkill.

He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Joyce Gidley Hladik; sons, William Hladik, Jr. (Mary), Kirk Hladik, Christopher Hladik (Kerry); son-in-law, Byron Thrailkill; brother, John Hladik; grandsons, Jason Hladik (Nicole) and Cody Thrailkill; and great grandchild, Hadyn Thrailkill.

The family will receive friends on Friday, July 15 from 4:00-6:00 PM at Cavin-Cook Funeral Home. A Mass will be held at 1:30 PM on Saturday, July 16 at

St. Therese Catholic Church, Mooresville, with Father Mark Lawlor officiating. A short reception at the church will follow.
