William Neil Morrow, 97, of Cleveland, NC, passed away on Thursday, December 26, 2019. He was born January 13, 1922 in Mt. Ulla, NC. He was a son of the late George Lee Morrow and Carrie McLean Morrow. On June 21, 1942, he married Margaret Blackwelder who precedes him in death. Neil proudly served his country in the US Army during World War II in Europe. He was retired from Fiber Industries and last worked at Twin Oaks Golf Course. He was a member of Triplett United Methodist Church. He was a member of the Men's Bible Class, a former member of the Methodist Men and served as Assistant Scout Master for 25 years. For 10 years of his retirement, he spoke to over 12,000 5th grade students at the The Price of Freedom Museum where he would tell stories about his World War II service. Neil is also preceded in death by sisters, Ruth Sharpe, Elizabeth Ketchie and Rachel Bustle; brothers, Price, Carl, John Bell and George Morrow, numerous nieces and nephews.

Services will be held on Monday, December 30 at 2:00 PM in the Chapel of Cavin-Cook Funeral Home with Rev. Joe Collins officiating.
