Bill served on the Board of Directors for Sherrills Ford-Terrell Fire Company and was part of the Board of Directors that built the current fire station. Bill later became very passionate serving on the board of Richard's Coffee Shop and Museum in Mooresville, NC, which honors past and present service members of our United States Military. Bill also was a member of American Legion Post 103 in Mooresville, NC. Bill had many hobbies from

woodcarving to RV'ing. He was most passionate as an amateur radio operator (KI40CN) and enjoyed many hours leading the "Net's" and talking to people around the world.
