William Leslie Weaver, “Les,” 72, of Mooresville, passed away peacefully at the Gordon Hospice House in Statesville, NC surrounded by family on November 14, 2018 after a lengthy battle with pancreatic cancer.

Les was born on July 31, 1946 in Kannapolis, NC, to the late Sarah Goodwin Weaver and William Lloyd Weaver Jr. He graduated from A.L.
